(Q1) (A) Explain the following statements:

(B) Answer the following:

- (ii) 'Higher intelligence cause improved learning in the students.' What are the dependent and independent variables in the statement given above?
- (iii) What is ontology and epistemology of research?
- (iv) Identify the type of sampling in the following:

- (v) What is the difference between fundamental and applied research? Construct example.

(Q2) (A) Critically examine functionalist view on institution of family. How do these help us in understanding the emerging forms of family in the present Indian society? Can there be family without marriage?
