Q3. Ramesh, a resident of Neemrana, Rajasthan, entered into a written agreement on January 15, 2026, to sell his agricultural land bearing the address Survey No. 45/2 and measuring 5 acres to Suresh for ₹50 lakhs, with possession and registration to finalize by February 15, 2026, upon full payment. Suresh paid ₹10 lakhs as advance but failed to pay the balance or complete registration despite repeated demands, forcing Ramesh to incur losses from lost rental income. As a lawyer, draft a plaint on behalf of Ramesh against Suresh for specific performance of the sale agreement, or as an alternative, recovery of ₹10 lakhs advance with 18% interest and damages of ₹5 lakhs. Invent details wherever necessary. (20 marks)
